"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

Automated External Defibrillators (AED) are on the grounds of these events. Location for the first AED is in the Casacde Hall (Obedience Building). It is located in the corridor across from the Fairgrounds Office. Enter the building from the south side. Second AED will be with the Lookingglass Volunteer Fire Department. These volunteers will have a First Aid Booth parked in front of Douglas Hall.

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

- 1. When you submit your entry, you and any person attending the show as a result of your entry, voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and agree to comply with the COVID-19 Rules and Guidelines as required by the State of Oregon.
- 2. General Rules: The UKC members, fairgrounds Staff and Parking crew are all working hard to put on the best event we can during these challenging times. To get approval for our event we agreed to make changes for this years' shows. We expect all participants to comply with the COVID-19 procedures as defined by the Oregon Health Authority.
 - A. Try to arrive at the ring no more than 15 minutes prior to your scheduled ring time and please leave after your breed has completed judging.
 - B. If possible please bring only your dog to ringside. Bring your dog ready to show from your motor home, grooming space or vehicle.
 - C. Day parking will be located across the street from the Show Grounds.
 - D. The Mask requirements are changing rapidly in our state. If Masks are required in certain areas of the show grounds, please bring your own and comply with the current regulations that will be published in the Judging Program and at the show.
 - E. If you do not have an approved mask, they will be available at Parking and at the Club Table.
 - F. No blow dryers are permitted indoors. Use of a blow dryer is only allowed in the overnight and day parking areas, or within your own pop up outside. Pop ups can be set up in the Amphitheatre Park. Bring extension cords if you plan to use a dryer. Limited power is available at the small, covered pavilion in the area. Please cleanup excessive hair.
- 3. Friday Specialty
 - A. We understand specialty events take longer and the show and people will be staying at ringside longer when they have multiple dogs to show. When you bring a dog and crate to your ring area, please keep a social distance from the other set ups. Remove your crates when you exit the room. We will give your specialty area plenty of room so stay spread out to social distance.
 - B. No raffles or other group activities unless approved by the show chairman and the event must comply with the State of Oregon Rules.
- 4. All Breed Shows on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday
 - A. Try to do necessary grooming before you come to the show. Report to your ring area close to the time you expect to be in the ring. Leave soon after the judging of your breed. Most of the rings will be outside, please try to social distance. For the inside rings, the number of people in a building will be determined by the OHA Covid regulations regarding occupancy of a fairgrounds building on the date of the show.

- B. No grooming ringside--brush/comb to touchup only. Bring your dog ready to show, leave when judging is completed.
- C. No pop up tents ringside, except those placed by the Show committee.
- D. Maintain social distancing at the ring entrance. Armbands will be at an unattended table ringside. There will be no public catalog so know your dogs' armband number. Report to ring steward when your number is picked up.
- E. Exhibitors must provide their own means for cleaning up after their dogs. There will be no public scoops. Bring your doggie bags. If you don't have doggie bags, they will be available on the grounds, at the rings and at the club table.
- F. IF COVID REGULATIONS CHANGE FROM THE RULES IN THE PREMIUM LIST, NEW OR MODIFIED RULES WILL BE PUBLISHED IN THE JUDGING PROGRAM. The show will operate in compliance with the Covid Regulations set forth by the Oregon Health Authority applying on the dates of the shows.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY UNATTENDED DOGS IN CARS IN THE PARKING LOT.

Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf. Most important to note are the following:

- Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf.

If you have questions or need assistance with registration or obtaining an extension, please contact the AKC Special Services Department at: awards@akc.org or (919) 233-9767 (followed by selecting option 4).

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotti Romagnoli, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeens, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on a table or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Mudik (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Whippets & Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.



AKC 4 & Under 6 Months Beginner Puppy Competition Saturday

Entry Fee: \$22.00 per puppy

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in each Breed/Variety, each Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Breed/Variety winner will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements. The Miscellaneous Class Competition. The Foundation Stock Service Class Competition will be judged same as above followed by a Miscellaneous 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. The Foundation Stock Service All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for FSS entries.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a nonprofessional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four and under Six Months Puppy Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form) The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/ Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
